Colorectal cancer is the third leading cause of cancer-related deaths in women in the United States, and the second leading in men.



Colorectal cancer risk factors you can change:

Studies show that people who are able to pick the test they prefer are more likely to actually get the test done. Increasing the use of all recommended colorectal cancer tests can save more lives and is cost-effective.

**Colorectal cancer screening saves lives. If you're 50 years old or older, talk to your doctor about getting screened.**
